The Case For Trees - Forestry Commission Guidance

The key points are:

- Trees dramatically improve the streetscene
- Trees help combat climate change
- Trees can deliver an economic dividend
- Trees provide numerous social benefits

Towards the end of the report is a development management checklist outlining the practical issues to consider around trees when planning a development. It is recommended that trees and woods are considered right from the start in any planning application process.
